Subject: Alberta's Bill 10 Law and Related Guidance to All Schools are Profoundly Anti-Christian

Bill10 has been referred to as the Gay-Straight Alliance (GSA) Bill, Transgender Rights Bill, and Legislation for Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transsexual, and Queer (LGBTQ) Students.

What are the Implications of Bill 10?

- Parents can no longer have their children opt-out of sexuality instruction.
- Students, regardless of age, are to be encouraged to experiment and self-identify along a “sexual minority spectrum” spanning 56 expressions.
- Parental rights and family legal protections in Alberta Family Law are circumvented by policies that allow students to live-out sexual identities at school that are kept secret from parents.
- The Alberta Teachers Association (ATA) wishes to use GSAs to “*Effect educational and social change by striving to move beyond tolerance [of sexual minority lifestyles].*”
- Over 20 ATA publications and endorsed references aimed at ending “homophobia” in Alberta schools violate the freedoms of religion, speech and association of many students.

What is Bill 10 Court Challenge Organization?

The organizational goal is to lift the blindness among many in the Body of Believers in Alberta and breach the apparent Christian complacency on this matter. This email has been sent to lead and associate pastors at most of the Christian churches across Alberta.

What is Requested of Pastors and Their Churches?

- Periodically inform pastors of Bill 10 related events and news, such as planned rallies or legal developments initiated by this and other organizations active in challenging Bill 10.
