Name calling

Is name-calling of social conservatives "LGBTQ-phobes" appropriate? The application of "homophobia" has expanded to: "A disparaging or hostile attitude or a negative bias, which may be overt or unspoken and which may exist at an individual and/or a systemic level, towards people who are LGBTQ" [Ontario Curriculum]. Alberta Education defines what bullying is not: "Bullying behaviour is sometimes confused with conflict. Conflict is disagreement about different beliefs, ideas, feelings or actions. It is a normal part of healthy relationships." Social conservatives are not the bullies here.


