On 21 April 2019, the undersigned submitted an application for court challenge funding. To view the key portions of the submission [click here](#).

The objective of the Court Challenges Program is to provide individuals and groups in Canada with financial support to access the courts for the litigation of test cases of national significance. This support is also intended to clarify and assert certain constitutional and quasi-constitutional human rights in Canada. The expected results of the Court Challenges Program include the following:

- individuals or groups have access to funding to initiate or participate in test cases pertaining to rights and freedoms covered by the Program;
- perspectives of individuals or groups who receive funding are presented before the courts in test cases; and
- rights and freedoms covered by the Program are clarified and strengthened.

The Court Challenges Program is implemented and administered by a third party to avoid any real or perceived conflict of interest on the part of the Government of Canada.

The Expert Review Panel meets on 18 June 2019 to determine their final decision. It is requested that addressees review the submission details and engage in intercessory prayer as burdened by the Holy Spirit. May this application open eyes and bear fruit!
